It gives me great pleasure to tell you that winter has finally made it to “GOD’s Country” ... for the last few weeks we have been pretty much below freezing and some snow on and off ... but it’s been Wimpy at best!

Starting this morning about 7am we finally began to receive our most substantial snowfall of the Season. My good friends at the NWS missed it a little but we ended up with 6”-7”, as temps ranged from 17 -23 degrees today. The Lakes are frozen and the creeks should be in pretty good shape so low impact, slow speed trail breaking and that type of riding will be available this weekend should anybody be looking.

Kenny Creek was closer to 9” and my “guess” is up around MP 127-131 they should have received close to 9” also. Quite honestly though I have NO recon on that.

Riders have been back in the Dutch Hills although it’s still pretty early to ride back there too; remember there’s still mining equipment that can be “hit” early in the season. If you must ride, and ride back there ... then the road is the quickest and safest way in ... so do what you will.
