Gate Creek Cabins offers a wide range of Snowmobile Tours, for the absolute beginner ... or the more exhilarating ... advanced backcountry excursions (single and Multi-day). Most Tours start just out our back-door ... we're located just 30 air miles South of Mt. McKinley. With incredible vista's of Mt. McKinley, Mt. Hunter, Mt. Foraker and the entire Alaska Range, hold your breath ... this Beautiful Country is a land of a thousand postcards! Enjoy Wildlife & Spectacular Scenery ... so don't forget your camera! All our Ski-Doo's are 06/07 models, with the rider friendly "Rev" chassis. Incredible weight-to-power ratio means they're easy to handle, for people of all sizes. All our machines are well maintained and are in new/like new condition.

CHEECHAKO (3 1/4 Hour Tour): Snowmobiling is one of the easiest and most enjoyable recreational activities that Alaska has to offer. It's an adventure for the entire family regardless of age ... so relax; your Safety is our #1 priority. Your experienced guide(s) will provide you with instructions on how to safely operate the World's most popular Snowmobiles. Just down the trail our Cheechako Tour introduces you to snow covered meadows, forests and groomed trails. The landscape is highlighted by "Crystal Clear" views of Mt. McKinley, Mt. Hunter & Mt. Foraker ... please ask about the "Sacagawea Tree" and its unbelievable Historical significance. We'll stop at one of the local lodges that features a magnificent view of Mt. McKinley and "Alaska's Best Homemade Pie". It's a great place to "warm up" and discuss each riders progress. Typically the trip home seems quicker because you've just learned the basics and you'll be teaming with confidence. We can take you places on Ski-Doo Snow Machines that you just can't get to any other way (unless of course you own a helicopter)! The **Cheechako Tour** includes: Snowmobile & Helmet, Fuel, Coffee and Snack.

The BOONDOCKER (5 1/2 hour Tour): If you're ready for the next Step, the **BoonDocker** challenges your abilities (a little bit or a lot bit) which ever you're ready for !! Recommended for advanced beginners and up, get ready to "Surf Powder", it's clearly "what's next", we'll Peg your Fun Meter! With thousands of acres of riding possibilities, the **BoonDocker** is a "point and shoot" experience that will take you to new heights ... perfect for the explorer in each of us. It's a great way to learn the area and familiarize you with the landmarks, while challenging yourself to new skill levels. We can customize this ride for whatever your desire, there's just sooooo much to see ... if we can do it with the time allowed (and based on the ability of the entire group) ... we'll make it happen! Because this ride requires more proficiency, there's a chance of getting stuck, so be ready to pitch in!

This is an excellent "**Team Building**" opportunity, and Perfect for "Corporate Outings" ... since we can only move forward at the pace and function as a "total team". We don't leave people on the trail ... ever! The **Boondocker** can cover high country, deep powder, search for wildlife and photo opts, the possibilities are endless ... and No Two Boondockers are alike! We'll stop for lunch, talk about the possibilities ... then determine the last half of our ride. Because it's an exploration Tour, it's probably our most popular ride. Most families see places and try things on their snow machines they never thought possible (Nothing goofy or dangerous) just a smidgen outside the comfort zone ... a little bit at a time :)

The **BoonDocker** is also very popular with our friends from the Lower 48 (America) and Europe. They spend so much time riding groomed trails ... they may never experience what we take for granted. Open powder riding is what most experienced riders live for ! **Come experience the true excitement of our open powder adventure ... we call it the Boondocker!**

McKinley South (7 1/2 hour Tour): With all the excitement of the BoonDocker ... **McKinley South** most likely will become more of a destination ride, simply because of the time it takes to get there and back. It can have all the components of the BoonDocker Plus. Longer face time (with your sled) means more opportunities; the best riding is usually where the deepest snow is ... **McKinley South** separates the men from the boys ... so to speak. Higher Skill levels are required because we'll probably face more challenges, requires Hill Climbing to see Mt. McKinley up close and personal ... minimum intermediate experience levels recommended. This trip can be customized for parties with less experience, but want to ride longer ... to challenge their riding abilities.

Safety will always be our first concern, so feel confident we won't be riding into Avalanche Area's or other overtly dangerous situations. The Petersville Area is so diverse, the variety makes it easy to accomplish "**McKinley South**", from our back-door we could ride for a week and never cover the same ground twice. The Bunco Bump, Peters Hills, Dutch Hills, Alder Mt., Cache Creek/Dollar Creek, "Heaven", Wild Horse** just to name a few. (** Some Rides are only available from late February and based on snow conditions).

A Beginners Version: is an easy ride and non technical ... traveling up the Safari Lake Trail, past Bunco Lake, onto the Tokositna River (snow levels permitting). We'll position your party right at the edge of Denali National Park just 12 air-miles from the South Face of Mt. McKinley ... it's down right Spiritual !! Our only concern for beginning riders ... McKinley South ... is a Full 7 Hour Ride, with fewer breaks than the other rides simply because of time and the territory we plan to cover ... its about 75-80 miles round trip !! **McKinley South** includes: Snow Machine Rental & Helmet, Fuel, Snacks and Lunch.

4 Glacier's (10 Plus hour Tour): Hold on to your long John's this is a full day of face to face glacial excitement. We don't actually ride on the glaciers, but we'll put you so close you can hear the Glaciers "sweat"! This ride is best suited for later season ... better/deeper snow conditions with longer & warmer days. Side Hilling and Hill Climbing will be required, so know this going in, "Expect some Technical Riding"

4 Glaciers is a magnificent display of Alaska's Glacial Beauty, we'll visit Ruth, Tokositna, Kanikula, and Kahiltna Glaciers while covering about 110-120 miles of Alaska's most spectacular landscape. Digital cameras are highly recommended for picture crispness and quality ... you may never see beauty like this again in your lifetime. **I Love this ride!!**

There are multiple ways to get to the **4 Glaciers** so we'll play it by ear and see what the weather gives us. Well plan a nice sit down lunch at one of our favorite "Alaskan Getaway's". Warning: Stories told at these locations may or may not have any element of truth ... No Guarantees!! We'll top off with gas and make one more Glacier before turning our sleds homeward bound. Our Final stop before reaching the cabins is another "feedbag stop" ... where we'll introduce you to Petersville's "Best Food & Homemade Pies" (try the Rhubarb, you'll never eat better)... it's a full day that you'll never forget.

4 Glaciers may be the best single day trip available on snow machines ... we just never get tired of the Mountains Majesty or the magnificence of glacial beauty. **4 Glaciers** includes snowmachine Rental & Helmet, Fuel, Lunch, snacks and Dinner. ** This tour is best suited for late Spring Riding ... depending on snow conditions, Usually a March & April Expedition ... You'll brag about this one ... for a long time !!
